Thank you for your message; I would be happy to clear up your questions.

1. The membership is the only fee that we require for publication. We do occasionally require professional editing if the peer reviews have stated that is necessary, or if we find that to be necessary after looking at your final submission. However in cases like that, we will usually first suggest a peer proofread the article to try to avoid any additional costs. After a brief glance of your article, it seems like it does not require professional editing. One reviewer did suggest minor proofing from a colleague or critical friend. If you would like open access, there is an additional cost. This can either be purchased in a bundle with your membership, and more information regarding that can be found at: https://cgscholar.com/cg_support/en/docs/140-open-access-vs-premium-open-access. This can also be purchased after publication. If you would like to purchase a hard-copy issue, they are \$100, but we always have a 50% coupon available for authors to use. The hard-copy issue is not available until the issue in question has been completed.
2. The membership does not renew. A new membership must be purchased for each article. It does include a subscription and a few other benefits. Please see https://cgscholar.com/cg_support/en/docs/65-membership-benefits for more information about the benefits.
3. The membership is in place of any publication fee. The standard memberships cost \$200, and we do offer a student discount of \$100. The membership page for the Learner network can be found at: <https://thelearner.com/about/become-a-member>.
4. We require a separate membership purchase for each article to move forward in the publication process once it has passed peer review. Memberships last for one year and include the benefit of publishing one article. If multiple articles are submitted and accepted for publication, if the author decides to proceed to publication, a membership must be purchased for each article.
