

Your manuscript has been reviewed. Following are the comments of the first reviewer:

1. The topic of the paper is of urgent contemporary relevance and research in this area is still scarce especially so from Asian countries. The strength of the paper lies in the background and literature review that adequately covers the major themes in the field of deradicalisation and disengagement. It also describes and critiques the efforts by government and civil society in Indonesia in this regard. In doing so it shows a grasp of the main issues, the push and pull factors, the factors that contribute to successful reintegration and the problems with such programs.
2. The paper also demonstrates a theoretical grasp of research methodology and data analysis. However, the study described in the paper does not link up adequately with the previous sections on deradicalisation and disengagement.
3. The participants are interviewed about the experience of deradicalisation and disengagement and the impact of these experiences on their identities. This is potentially a rich area for exploration. Issues of stability and continuity of identity, self-worth and stigmatised identities, affiliations, identifications and identity, multiple identity dimensions versus singular identity, salience of ideology to identity, etc. have implications for deradicalisation and disengagement processes.
4. Although the literature review section on identity covers relevant identity issues, the study findings focus only on 'identity threat' and coping.
5. The findings are discussed as they relate to stress and coping without linking up to pertinent issues of disengagement such as processes of reintegration economically, socially, politically, and in personal areas of life, nor to potential risks of re-engagement. Nor is current identity threat and coping linked to relevant issues such as prior identity structure, social and other affiliations, self-worth, nor to the initial processes of radicalisation and engagement in the first place.
6. The interview schedule is described as including sections on how they were radicalized and engaged in jihadist movement as well their experience of participating in deradicalisation/ rehabilitation programs. These aspects are not discussed in the findings.
7. The sample size being seven is not a limitation to obtaining rich and complex data. However, it may be difficult to obtain such data in a single interview of an hour duration given the sensitive nature of the subject and the precarious position of former jihadist prisoners.
8. If the study findings are discussed within the framework of deradicalisation and disengagement in addition to the framework of stress and coping, the paper will be strengthened.


1. The research question needs to be refined and framed in the context of literature reviewed by you.
2. There are many problems with the language. I suggest that you may seek editorial help in revising the paper.
