The authors well wrote the manuscript with a well-addressed topic linked with the effect of halal awareness and traceability on consumer purchase decisions and focusing on the customer perspective on halal food product buying intentions in the internet era. At the same time, the consumer perspective emphasizes the factors contributing to halal knowledge and the purchasing decisions associated with halal products. Following are some suggestions and drawbacks in the study to improve its effectiveness.

1. Restructure the abstract to reflect the study purpose, focus, methods, and results of the study in the sequence. Also, add novelty/significance at the end of the abstract.
2. There is a need to elaborate on the importance of digital media. Also, the authors should explain the halal traceability by clearly stating the study objectives.

3. The literature review needs to be much more clearly written. Authors should articulate the section as Halal Food Information, Halal Traceability, Blockchain-based technology, followed by consumers' Purchase intention.
4. In the methodology section should be devised into subsections. There is also a need to add details regarding sampling techniques and total sample size. Add the complete detail of study measures with scales. Are the scales adapted or adapted by the scholar?
5. The authors have conducted a detailed analysis, and the results are well-reported by the authors. However, here are a few suggestions to make them more influential. For instance, I encourage authors to report descriptive statistics of the measures. Also, the validity and reliability results should be presented in tables.
6. The discussion section needs to be more detailed. Authors should first state their results, then explain them based on the contextual nature, and also should relate them with existing studies to reflect the theoretical and practical implications of conducting this study.

Additionally, religiosity, blockchain as a metric of traceability, and knowledge all influenced consumers' purchase decisions. The topic of this research is interesting and relevant. The authors review a good number of relevant literature and appropriately use it to set the background for their work. I found the quantitative research design used by the authors appropriate for the study. I also found that the manuscript was overall well-structured but very, unfortunately, not well-written. The manuscript also has a significant number of typos and or grammatical mistakes. The current version of the manuscript needs improvements. For instance,

- i. In the introduction section, the authors need to explain the main concept of the study. For instance, Considering the study's definition of halal food as "Islamic permissible food and ingredients following sharia," needs to be elaborated in detail.
- ii. The authors should enrich the literature review with separate headings for each concept for a better understanding of the readers. Also, the literature needs to be updated with the latest citations.

- iii. Which research methodology and sampling technique did the author authors apply? There is a need to add a detailed description of the sampling methodology for a clear understanding of the readers. Also, sampling details must be very apt and clear with the measures used to assess the study constructs.
- iv. The authors well presented the results of this study; however,
  - A table for KMO and Bartlett's Test should be added by the authors
  - There is a need to add the table of discriminant validity, and model fitness
  - The results of the mediation hypothesis need to be added and explained
- v. The discussion section is merged with research implications, just confining to the study novelty, which is not that novel. There is a need to discuss the study results in detail, independent of implications, clearly stating the significance of the results and their applicability per the study context in light of existing studies. There is also a need to add Conclusions and identify potential future research areas.
- vi. There are many grammatical issues in the article. There is a need to avail of the services of professional proof editors or native speakers to enhance the manuscript's readability.
