#### Reviewer 1

The study "Multicultural Education in Indonesia as a Function of Curriculum Development Strategies, Students' Cultural Competencies and Globalization" explores the influence of curriculum development methodologies and students' cultural competencies on multicultural education in Indonesian private schools. Also, the article investigates the moderating effect of globalization on curriculum development methodologies, students' cultural skills, and multicultural education in Indonesian private schools. Following primary data gathering technology employing survey methodology to collect data, authors applied the SmartPLS for analysis. The results are well presented by the authors. However overall, there are a few things that need stepwise improvement to make this work publishable.

The introduction of the paper is very short, and it is not catchy to attract the attention of the readers. Additionally, the contributions that the authors wanted to make are not clear enough. It further needs a consolidated presentation and explanation

Throughout the hypotheses section, the authors used similar research results to the existing research when they elaborated on their hypothesis without logical arguments. That weakens the arguments, and the current arguments are not persuasive enough to convince the readers that this paper has contributions. So please rewrite the hypotheses parts with more logical supports

Methodologically this study examines the effect of curriculum development methodologies and cultural competence on multicultural education. It also evaluates the impact of globalization on the function of curriculum development methodologies and students' cultural competencies in building and upgrading multicultural education in Indonesian private schools. My concern is how the questionnaires were distributed among the respondents. How much time it took, and what was the response rate?

The results are well presented. However, it is good to add a table presenting the cross-loadings of the study constructs. Also, the PLS figure for the full measurement model is recommended to be added by the authors.

The discussion is also presented well. However, there is still room for improvement. There is a need to present detailed implications with limitations and future directions.

Although the article is well-written and easy to read, it has some errors that must be carefully checked and corrected.

Authors should double-check their citations and match them with the end-text references. Moreover, there is a need to follow the APA 7th edition to record all the references in this study.

#### Reviewer 2

The start of the paper is not catchy and grabs the readers' attention; there must be a systematic flow of information in the introduction. The introduction of the topic is very brief. A detailed introduction is required to better understand the research gap and research problem as to how does it emerge from prior research in this field? What did we know about it before this study was done? How can this study advance our knowledge in this area? To put it another way, it is not an adequate justification to simply state there is a limited amount of research available on the topic. There are studies related to Multicultural Education and its application in the educational sector published in 2019-2018, which the authors have not properly utilized to devise the research gap and make the manuscript more influential and worth reading.

The literature review needs to be much more clearly written. The ideas are there, but they need to be explained further, and the ideas need to be more clearly linked together. An in-depth literature review is required to build a hypothesis with a clear understanding of the main concepts. Particularly need to build a stronger case for the moderation hypothesis. Most of the references are from 2016 or before; only a couple of 2018 studies are referred by the authors. In contrast, there are a lot many studies available regarding the area from 2019-2021, which the authors overlook. I suggest authors dig in deep in the latest literature to add something valuable to the existing body of literature.

Measures: I suggest adding a summary table for the items of all the study constructs with their factor loadings mean and SD values. What mode (online/ in-person) was used to collect data?

I encourage the authors to share some more details regarding the demographic characteristics of their respondents to better understand their impact on the dependent variable. Also, there is a need to provide detail regarding control variables based on their impact on DV.

How did the authors establish the discriminant validity of the constructs? The detail, as well as values, are missing.

Authors should add measurement model figures with impact sizes and R values to better understand the results.

The discussion section is merged with research implications by just confining to the study novelty, which is not actually that novel. There is a need to discuss the study results in detail independent of implications, clearly stating the significance of the results and their applicability as per the study context with specific examples from the hotel industry practices in the country. There is also a need to identify potential future research areas.

There are many grammatical issues in the article throughout, and especially authors are confused about where to use and where not to use "articles" and commas, singular or plural, etc.
